

General Parking Rules

(updated January 16, 2018)

1. A maximum of two parking permits will be issued per unit.
2. Only vehicles with licence plate numbers identified on the Winterra Information Form will be permitted.
3. Tenants will only be issued permits to those individuals listed on the 'K' form.
4. One license plate number on parking permit only applies to underground parking.
5. When two permits are issued, then both permits will display two license plate numbers identified on the Winterra Information Form and/or 'K' form. One of these permit holders must park underground.
6. All permits must be clearly visible.
7. Each unit will receive one visitor parking permit.
8. Non-resident vehicles must display visitor parking permit or they will be towed.
9. First time permits for owners/renters will be \$5 each. Vehicle and visitor permits can be replaced at a cost of \$5.
10. A vehicle cannot occupy the same outdoor parking stall longer than 3 weeks.
11. In the case of rented vehicles, courtesy cars, and other situations deemed necessary, temporary permits may be allocated.

Visitors/Guest/Service Vehicle Parking

1. Visitors/guests/service vehicles may only use the outside designated visitor/guest/service vehicle parking stalls.
2. Visitors/guest/service vehicles must display a valid visitor parking permit on the dashboard.
4. Visitors/guest parking is a maximum of 24 hours.
5. Vehicles with license plate numbers listed on the Winterra Information Form are not authorized to park in the Visitor/guest/service vehicle designated stalls.
6. If a Strata Lot Owner, Occupant, or Tenant parks in a Parking Stall designated for use by visitors, they will be warned on the first offence, fined on the second offense and towed on the third.
