IMPORTANT RECYCLING NEWS

Significant changes have taken place in the recycling market and Waste Connections of Canada, resulting in low tolerance for contamination. The majority of items that were deemed as recyclable are no longer accepted.

Over 65% of recyclables is now garbage and need to be placed in the garbage bins. Failure to do this has resulted in Winterra being fined by the waste management company.

Information posters have been placed on the bins, bulletins and was included in the November meeting minutes to avoid further fines.

Please remember - if it is not listed as acceptable for recycle, then it can be placed in the black bin. This does not include electronics, wood, furniture, or any metal product.

Q & A

Can newspapers go in the blue bin? **NO**

Aluminum cans? **YES!**

Can I put my recycling in a blue bag and throw it in the blue bin? **Surprisingly NO**

Can I put shredded paper in the blue bin? **NO**

How about pizza boxes? **NO, they have food on them.. but YES to other flattened cardboard!**

What about milk cartons? **NO waxed liners... but YES to cleaned plastic jugs with #2 written on the bottom...a win!**

OK, how about glass bottles? **still NO**

Council is looking into obtaining an additional blue container for refundable containers which would include wine and beer bottles. Your attention to the recycle bin will reduce Winterra costs and is of course appreciated.
