## Safety & Air Quality

Winterra is equipped with gas burning appliances. The risk involved with the use of gas is the of release hazardous levels of carbon monoxide (CO) in your home.

Carbon monoxide is a normal gas found in the air but it is hazardous and deadly when fuels are not burned completely or in the event of a clogged vent line or a faulty appliance. This gas is odorless, colorless and tasteless. Its presence can only be detected with a carbon monoxide monitor which will alert you.

It is a safety best practice to have a carbon monoxide monitor. There are many styles and brands with varying costs, available from any home store. They can be installed as easily as plugging it in to a standard electrical outlet in your hallway.

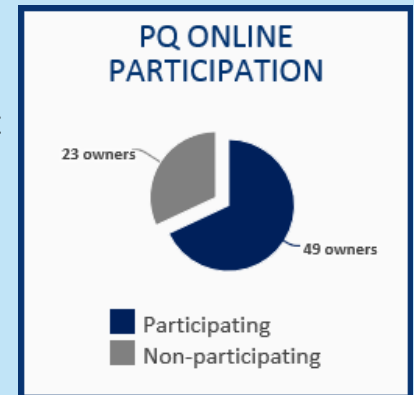
