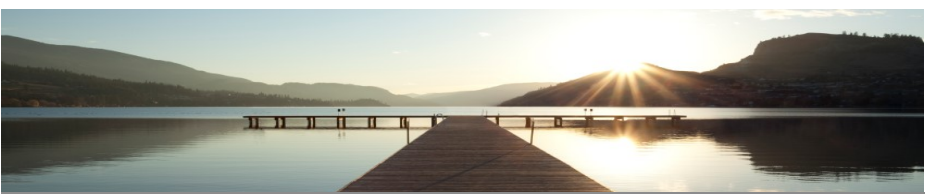
Update from our Board
